

Will

What will happen to my hard earned wealth, property and money after me? Will it go to desired hands? Will it be utilized legitimately? All these questions must be bothering you especially when you are in your retirement years. Making a “WILL” may reduce your tension to a greater extent.

Why to do will?

A will helps the successors/ beneficiaries in getting the title of the property and the distribution of the assets and avoids probable family disputes.

Who can do the will?

Any adult of sound mind and do a will in respect of his/her self-acquired properties and Assets. There is no age bar for a will.

Is there any standard format of will?

There is no specific format of a will. One may write the will on plain paper as per his/her wish. Wherever necessary we make suggestions for avoiding ambiguity, redundancy and making it more clear and specific off course with strict confidentiality.

If registration of will is mandatory?

Registration of will not mandatory. However, it is always advisable to get the will registered. This avoids the risk of theft, mutilation, tampering, overwriting or even challenges to prove truthfulness of the will.

What information and documents are required for will?

A person can bequeath his/her self-acquired property & Assets like, flat/ bungalow/ house, Gold/silver/other precious ornaments, vehicles, investments, bank /cash balances other valuables. You need to list out all these properties and assets with clear cut identification wherever possible. At the time of making a will you should be in good physical and mental condition. (We generally attach physicians' certificate to the will certifying your good mental and physical health)

What is the cost?

There is no stamp duty for the will. The only cost is that of the registration fees and our reasonable consultation fees.
